MR. HATCHER: There is a change. The Cabinet members or their representatives will not be at the airport. President Johnson will make a statement upon his arrival at the airport.

Mrs. Kennedy is on Air Force One.

As soon as President Johnson arrives at the White House, he will meet with Secretary of Defense McNamara and with Mr. McGeorge Bundy.

At 8:00 PM, President Johnson will meet with the bipartisan leadership of the Congress.

Q. Here?

MR. HATCHER: Here.

Q. Can you give us names on that?

MR. HATCHER: I can't. You can look it up on your records.

Q. Where?

MR. HATCHER: I don't know where, and I am getting this information over the telephone and trying to give it to you.

Q. But they are all in town, Andy, the bipartisan?

MR. HATCHER: Those who are in town will be present.

Now, President Kennedy's body will lie in repose, and that is the term, in the East Room of the White House tomorrow from 10:00 AM through 6:00 PM.

This is the order in which the body will be viewed:

At 10:00 AM, the family.

At 11:00 AM, President Johnson, The Speaker, ex-Presidents, and members of the Executive Branch of the Government holding Presidential appointments.

At 2:00 PM, the Supreme Court and the Federal Judiciary.

At 2:30 PM, Members of the Senate, the House, Governors of the 50 states and territories.

At 5:00 PM, the diplomatic corps.
