Interview:

Officer J. M. Smith was asked about his testimony before the Warren Commission when he stated that he confronted a Secret Service Agent.

Officer Smith stated that he remembers going back to the parking lot area in back of the knoll. He remembers walking there with a Deputy Sheriff but doesn't recall his name. Officer Smith had his revolver drawn and after getting to the parking lot area, had just started to holster his gun, when he observed a man on the parking lot near the railroad tracks. The man told Officer Smith that he was Secret Service and flashed his I.D. Officer Smith never examined the I.D. but continued searching the area. He did not notice the actions of the Secret Service man after that.
