

New High U.S. Budget Is Studied

\$98-103 Billion Range for Fiscal 1965 Is Revealed

WASHINGTON — (AP) President Johnson is attempting to work out a federal budget ranging between \$98 billion and \$103 billion for the 1965 fiscal year starting next July 1, the White House said Tuesday.

The largest amount ever spent in one year was in 1945, the year World War II ended. The figure: \$98.3 billion. The late President Kennedy submitted to Congress last January a budget calling for expenditure of \$98.5 billion in the current fiscal year. But Secretary of the Treasury Dillon has said actual spending probably will be about \$100 billion that, and thus not a record.

Valenti To Serve As Johnson's Aide

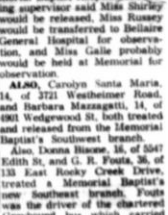

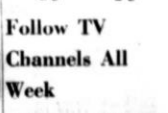
